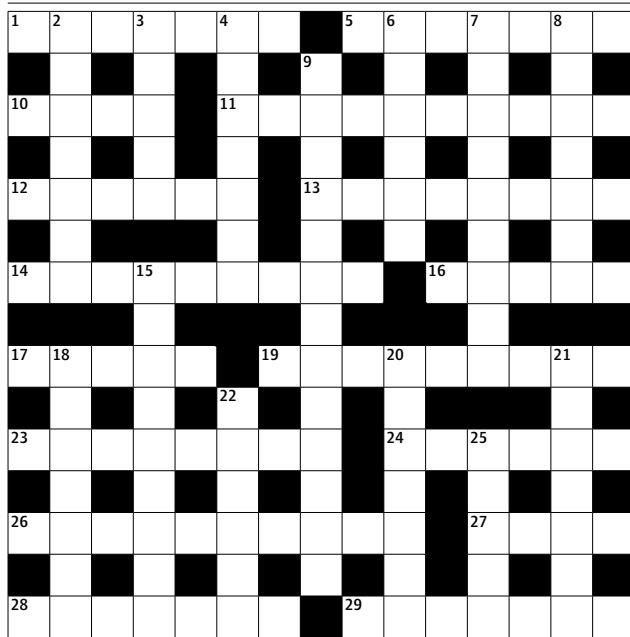


# Guardian cryptic crossword
