Half the clues work thus: "Constructed criminality" would lead to BUILT/GUILT, "Liquid grinder" to MILK/ MILL and "Life-changing river" to FILE/NILE. Either may be the correct solution to enter in the grid, but the 26 squares of the perimeter need to contain all the letters of the alphabet, which will determine the correct one to be entered.
