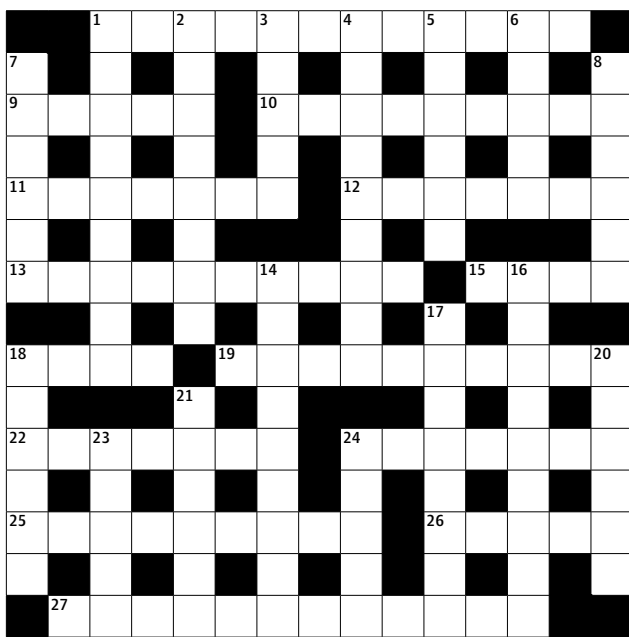


Guardian cryptic crossword
