Scissors

Glue (PVA or Pritt Stick)

A weight, such as a coin or marble

DO

- 1 Cut along the edges of the house and crease along the folds
- 2 Repeat for the chimney
- 3 Cut out the roof
- 4 Glue the edges of the house and then attach together
- 5 Now repeat for the chimney
- 6 Put your marble or coin inside the house to weight it
- 7 Glue the roof to the house, and the chimney to the roof
- 8 Become a property tycoon and print out more houses at theguardian.com/lifeandstyle/craft
