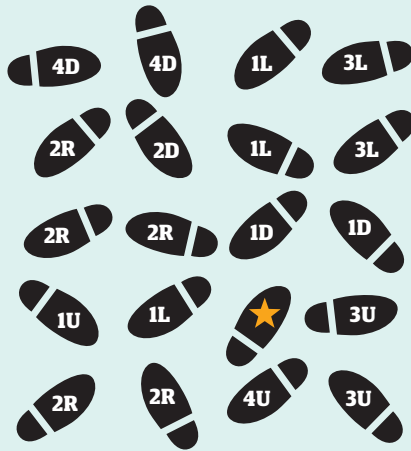

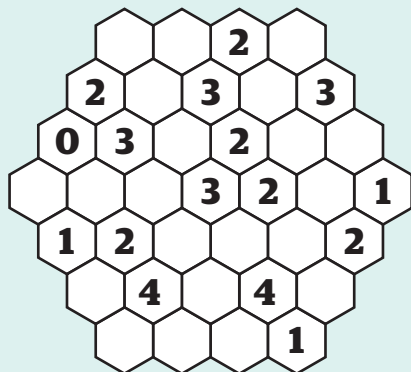
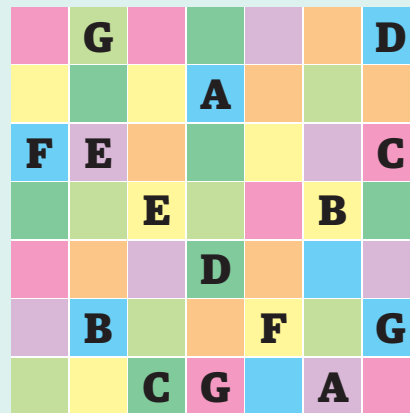


3 Strictly ballroom

4 Myriad

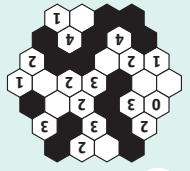
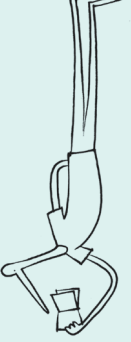
Complete the Myriad grid so that all the rows and columns, and all squares of the same colour, contain the letters A to G.

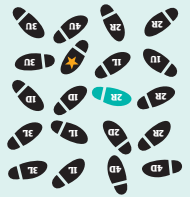
