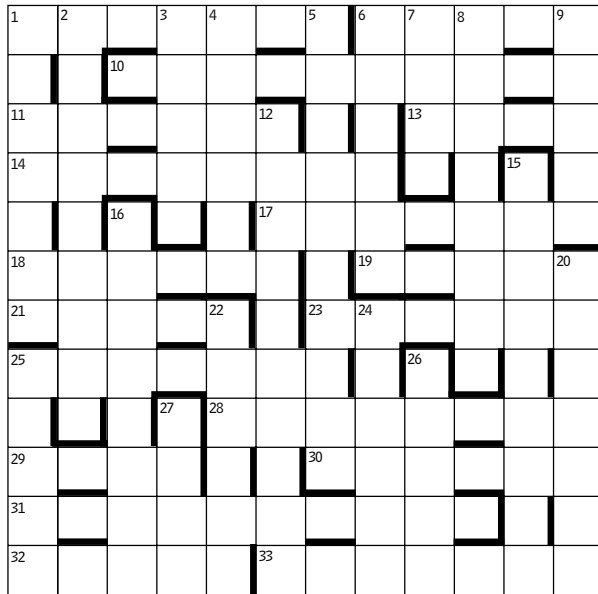

No more than one letter in any across answer forms the misprint in a down entry.
