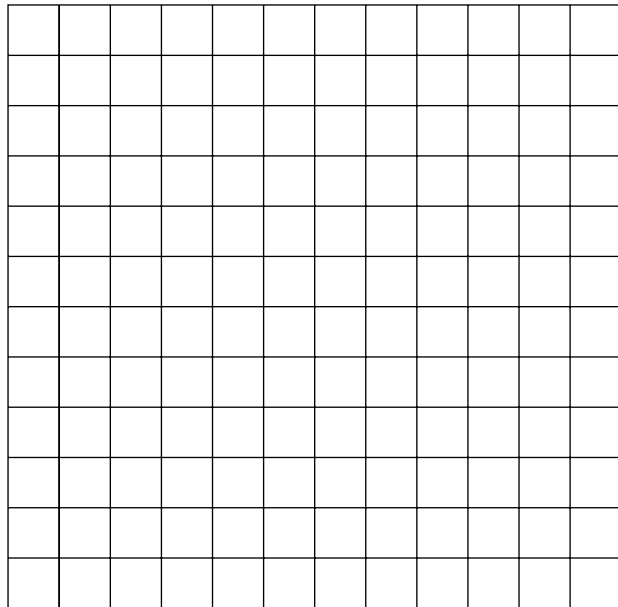


AZED No. 2,157 'Carte Blanche' COMPETITION PUZZLE
